ERASMUS Cooking Competition

Rules of the Competition

1. The Organizers

- 1.1. The organizers of the competition are the Faculty of Management at the National University of Political Studies and Public Administration (SNSPA) and the Culture MIX Cultural Center.
- 1.2. The Faculty of Management is the youngest structure at the National University of Political Studies and Public Administration (SNSPA), launched in 2009.
- 1.3. The Culture MIX Cultural Center has been founded in 2015 as part of the Faculty of Management from SNSPA. Culture MIX is concerned with organizing cultural activities for SNSPA students.

2. The Competition

- 2.1. The cooking competition Potluck Challenge is organized with the occasion of the first edition of the experiential educational program: **Experiences. Recreated Markets. ReThink Food** (in Romanian: **Experiențe. Piețe recreate. ReThink Food**).
- 2.2. The cooking competition is open for all SNSPA students and for ERASMUS students currently studying in SNSPA, who are passionate about cooking.
- 2.3. Each participant is required to bring a dish cooked by himself/ herself, that he/ she will allow voters to sample during the competition.
- 2.4. Each participant may bring only one dish.
- 2.5. The competition takes place in the Multifunctional Room, 1st of April, 2016, between 12:00 and 15:00.
- 2.6. The competitor agrees to be present in the Multifunctional Room during the entire competition duration: on the 1st of April, 2016, between 12:00 and 15:00.
- 2.7. The competitor agrees to show his/ her identity card to a representative of the Organizer when receiving his/ her expositional space in the Multifunctional Room.
- 2.8. The Faculty of Management and the Culture MIX Cultural Centre provide each participant with plates, forks and napkins.

2.9. Each participant is asked to send an e-mail with their name, faculty affiliation and telephone number at edu@facultateademangement.ro by 29th of March 2016. The subject of the e-mail must be POTLUCK CHALLENGE SUBSCRIPTION.

3. Awarding mechanism

3.1. The awarding mechanism comprises of a popular vote, given by any SNSPA community member (student, teacher, and other staff member) after tasting the dishes presented by the participants.

3.2. Voters (student, teacher, and other staff member) will be given a voting card when they enter the Multifunctional Room.

3.3. The vote consists of placing the voting card on the table corresponding to the name of the contestant.

3.4. At 15:00 hours, a jury consisting of one volunteer representative of the contestants and one volunteer representative of the Faculty of Management staff will count the voting cards for each contestant.

3.5. Two awards will be given to the participants: one for the ERASMUS student who manages to gather the most votes from the public, the other for the non-ERASMUS student who manages to gather the most votes from the public.

3.6. The awards consist of books and bio honey products offered by the partners of **Experiences. Recreated Markets. ReThink Food.**

3.7. The names of the winners will be communicated online on www.facultateademangement.ro and on www.facebook.com/Faculty.of.Management.SNSPA.

3.8. The winners may claim their awards with an identity card.

4. Final Dispositions

4.1. The rules of the competition are compulsory for all of the participants.

4.2. By sending the e-mail with their personal data, the participants agree to allow the Organizers to use these information for purposes connected to validation of their subscription to the competition, for giving the award and for promotional purposes, related to the competition.
